4. All the candidates who have successfully submitted their online applications have been called for examination. Hence, before appearing for the examination, candidates must ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria in all respects as stipulated in the Adm. Circular No. 646 dated 17.08.2023.

5. Any request for change of Paper / Date / Session / Venue will not be entertained.

6. **The link for downloading of the call letter will be provided by the TCS iON on the registered email ID by 01.02.2026.** Candidates who have successfully submitted their on-line application are requested to download call letter and read it carefully before coming to examination.

8. Identity Verification -

- (1) Candidates are requested to bring **2 hard copy/print out of call letter for each paper**, Original Identity Card of MSETCL (**Colour Xerox will not be accepted**) and one photocopy of MSETCL's Identity Card/ Letter of Cognizance (**Colour Copy**).
- (2) If any candidate is appearing for multiple papers, he must bring a separate set of call letters and photocopies of the MSETCL Identity Card/ Letter of for each paper. Each set, consisting of one call letter and one photocopy of the MSETCL Identity Card/ Letter of Cognizance (**Colour Copy**), should be stapled together and handed over to the invigilator before the commencement of each examination.
- (3) The Identity Card of MSETCL issued by the Competent Authority shall only be considered for identity verification. Candidates without a valid Official Identity Card issued by the Competent Authority of MSETCL must present a Permission Letter (Letter of Cognizance) in the prescribed format, issued by an officer not below the rank of Executive Engineer. Failure to provide either of the documents may result in the candidate being denied entry to the examination.
- (4) Candidate's name as appearing on the call letter shall exactly match with the name as appearing on the photo identity proof / Letter of Cognizance, hence candidates are advised to take special care while filling in their Application form.
- (5) **For Female Candidates** - Their names as appearing on the Call Letter (provided by them during the process of registration) should exactly match with the name as appearing on the MSETCL's Identity Card/ Letter of Cognizance. Female candidates who have changed first/ middle / last name post marriage will be allowed only if they produce original gazette notification/original marriage certificate/affidavit in original on stamp paper.

9. The Candidates reporting late (i.e. after the reporting time specified on the call letter) for whatsoever reason, will not be permitted to appear for the examination.

10. Candidates appearing for the examination should make their own arrangement of Transportation and Accommodation.

11. Candidates can claim TA/DA as per Company's rules.
12. Use of Books, Notebooks, Calculators, Watch Calculators, Pagers, Mobile Phones, Bluetooth Devices, Electronic Gazettes/Devices, etc. are not permitted in this examination. Candidates are advised not to bring any of the banned items to the venue of examination as safety arrangement cannot be assured. Any candidate found resorting to any unfair means or malpractice or any misconduct while appearing for the examination including giving/receiving help to/from any candidate during the examination will be disqualified. Also any act of misconduct during the examination will be viewed seriously.
13. Anyone found to be Disclosing, Publishing, Reproducing, Transmitting, Storing or Facilitating Transmission and Storage of Test Contents in any form or any information therein in whole or part thereof or by any means verbal or written, electronic or mechanical or taking away the papers supplied in the examination hall or found to be in unauthorized possession of test content is likely to be prosecuted and liable for facing disciplinary action.
14. No candidates will be allowed to enter the hall after the commencement of the examination.
15. Candidates will not be allowed to leave the examination hall during examination period.
16. The possibility of occurrence of some problem in the administration of the examination cannot be ruled out completely which may impact test delivery and/or result from being generated. In that event, every effort will be made to rectify such problems, which may include movement of candidates and/or delay in test. In such case, administration may re-conduct the examination.
17. Chance not availed for whatsoever reason will be considered as lost. No representation in this regard shall be entertained.
